About JSTOR

Scholarly Journal Archive

> **Mission:**

- (1) create a trusted archive of important scholarly literature
- (2) to extend access to that archive as broadly as possible.
- > Originally conceived at The Andrew W. Mellon Foundation in 1994
- > Established as an independent not-for-profit organization in August 1995
- > Initially a pilot project (University of Michigan) to provide electronic access to the backfiles of ten journals in two core fields, economics and history
- > Offices in New York City and Ann Arbor, Michigan USA



The importance of Archive

- How does an user apply the Archive?
 - The change of SSH researchers' using habit and resource type
 - Applying early period's resource is getting more and more important for basic disciplines
- Trend of library collecting resources
 - Libraries collect not only the latest resources, but also think highly of value of the early period's resources
 - Can current e-journals and databases fulfill users' needs or not?
 - Can print journals recover e-journals' time lag or not?
 - Journal Archive and Institutional Repository are the trend in libraries
 - Support from government to form library consortia
 - More and more digital archive programs

Publisher Participants*

- 1,064 journals signed from 532 publishers
- 773 available now, rest of them in the “queue”
- 47 disciplines covered
- Coverage from 1665 – 2007
 - 46% of titles have moving wall of 0-3 years
 - 88% of titles have moving wall of 0-5 years
- Participating publishers span the globe
including: Argentina, Australia, Costa Rica, Croatia, France, Germany, Hungary, Japan, Nigeria, South Africa

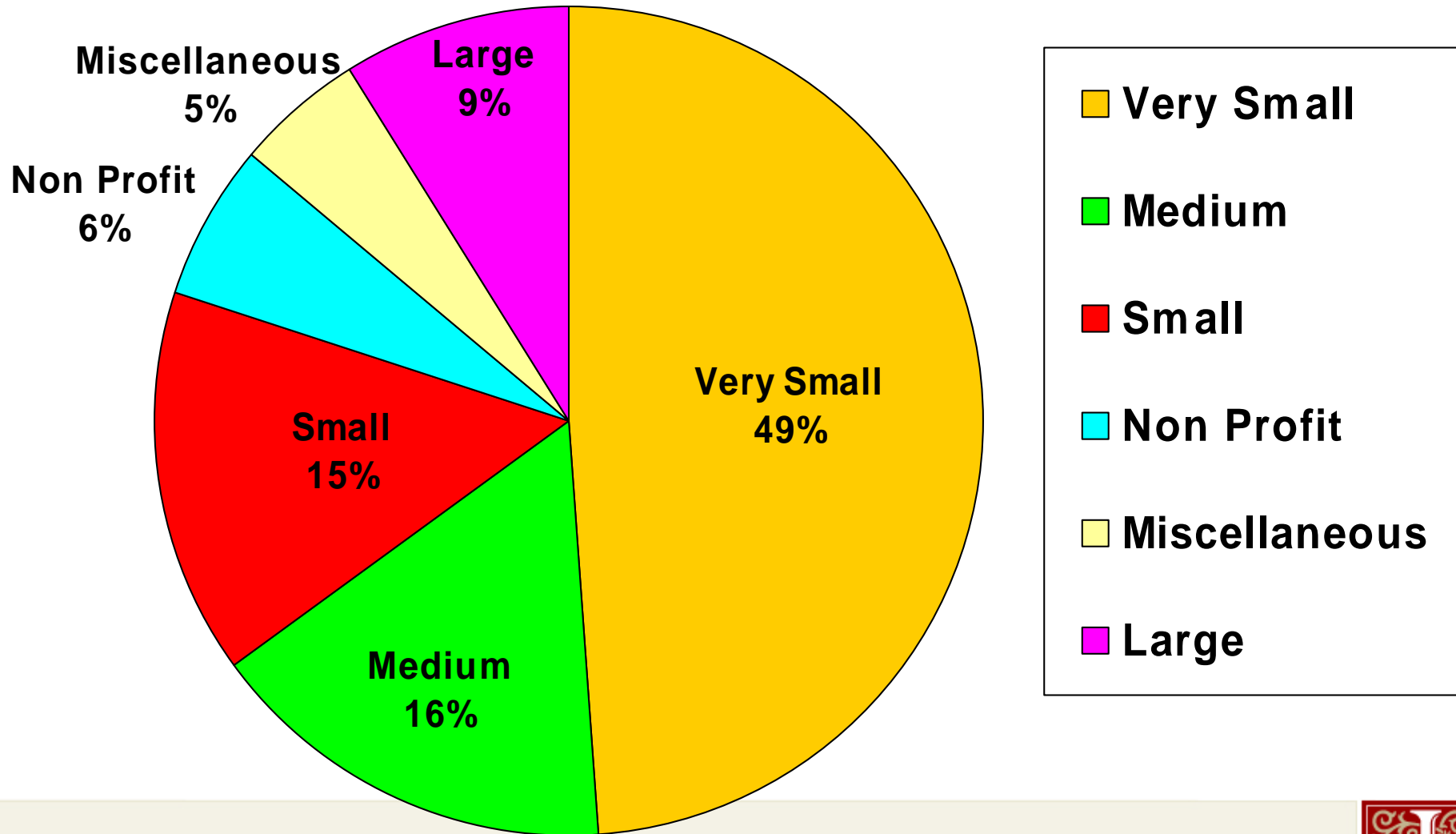
Library Participants*

- Total of 4,558 participants
- **2,137** U.S. and **2,421** in other countries
- JSTOR can be found in 135 countries;
- 53% of JSTOR participants are now outside the U.S.

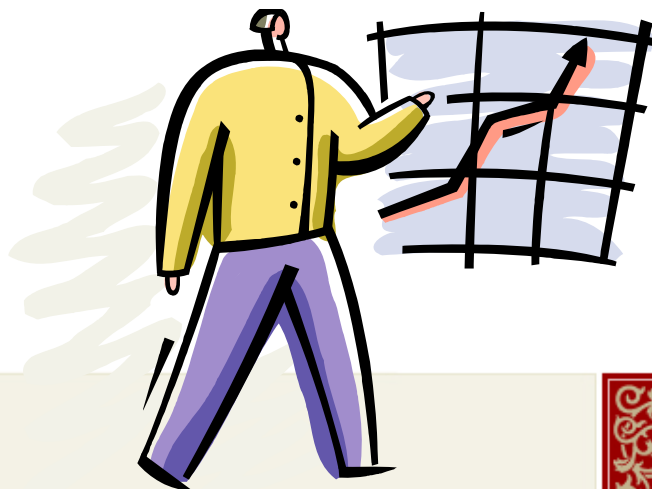

- > JSTOR Occupation of Participants : China 40%
- > 2006-2008 JSTOR Increase of Participants China (including HK, Macau) : 42%
- > 2006-2008 Growth of Collections :
 - 2006-2008 China : the growth of Collection is 92%
- > 2006-2008 Average increasing number of Collections' subscription:
 - China : Avg. 4.1-4.6
 - CALIS : Avg. 4.7-5.2

Life Sciences Collection

Minimum of 160 titles focused in Biological, Health and General Sciences

- Combination of Health & General Sciences and Biological Sciences Collections
- Largest Collection in JSTOR – 5.5 million pages, to grow to 7 million
- Able to provide access to combined content at lower cost to community
- ACF credits provided to participants who migrated from Health & General Sciences and Biological Sciences to Life Sciences; new AAF's automatically assessed in 2008 invoice



Arts & Sciences VI

Minimum 120 titles with an areas studies & social sciences focus

- Years range from 1837 to 2009
- 28 total disciplines currently covered
- Will provide greater internationalization of JSTOR content
- Will include important French, Asian Studies, and Latin American Studies titles
- Will complement the Arts & Sciences I, Arts & Sciences II, and Arts & Sciences Complement Collections



19th Century British Political Pamphlets

At the invitation of RLUK (Research Libraries UK, formerly CURL), JSTOR collaborated on their bid to the JISC Digitization Program. The project envisions:

- Digitizing 20,000+ 19th Century British Pamphlets that focus on key Parliamentary debates and figures
- RLUK libraries will contribute pamphlets to be digitized to JSTOR's technical specifications at the University of Southampton
- JSTOR will incorporate the pamphlets into the archive, increasing research pathways to the material by assigning DOIs and opening it to public search engines and other gateways



Ireland Collection

At the invitation of Queen's University Belfast, JSTOR collaborated to help develop an electronic library of core Irish materials:

- Project encompasses 100 journals (including some no longer publishing), 200 monographs, and 2,500 manuscript pages
- JSTOR, working closely with Queen's, will license copyrighted works from publishers
- Queen's will digitize the materials to JSTOR's specifications; JSTOR will take responsibility for making them accessible and their long-term preservation
- Majority of journals currently have no online presence

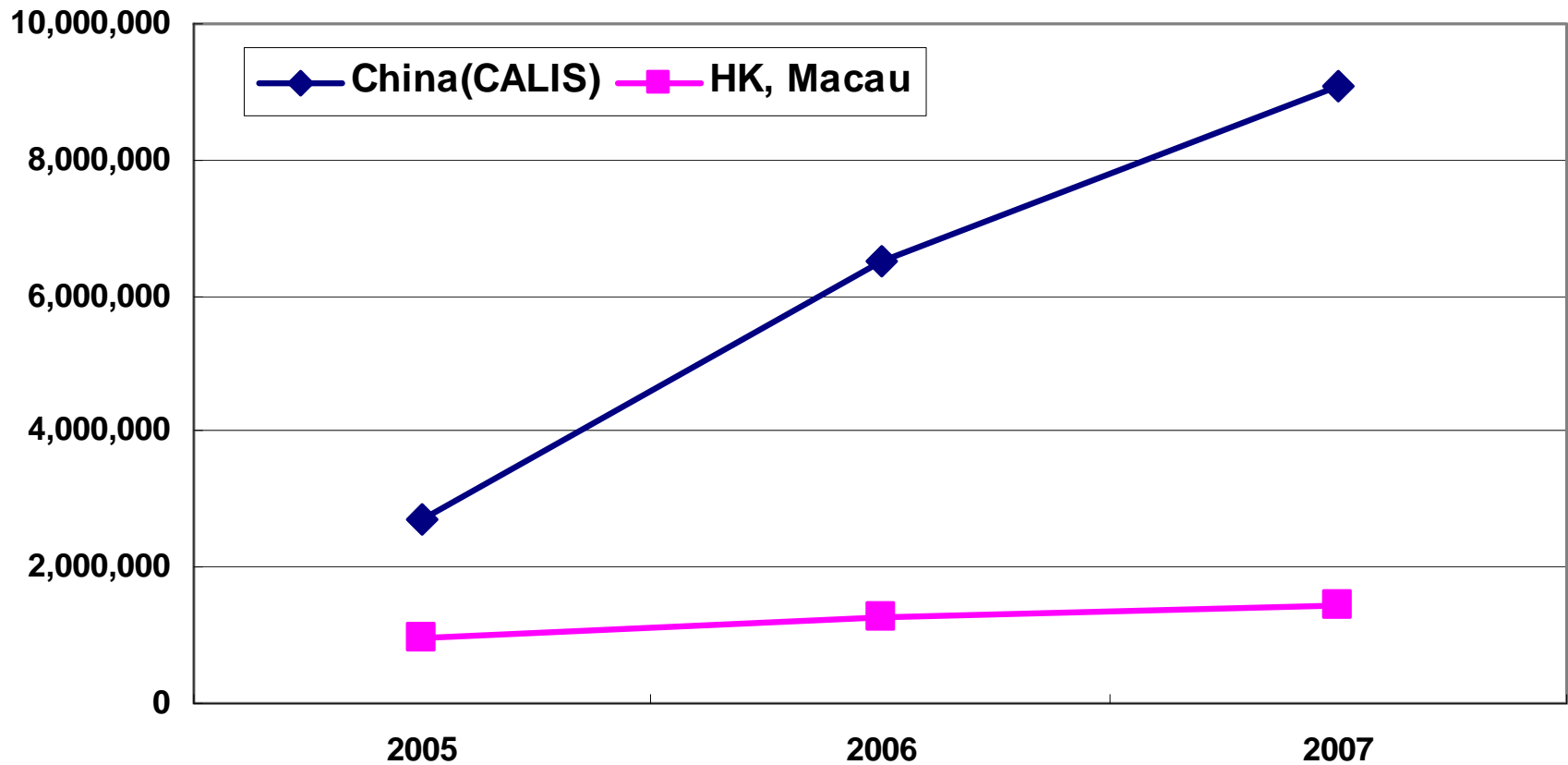

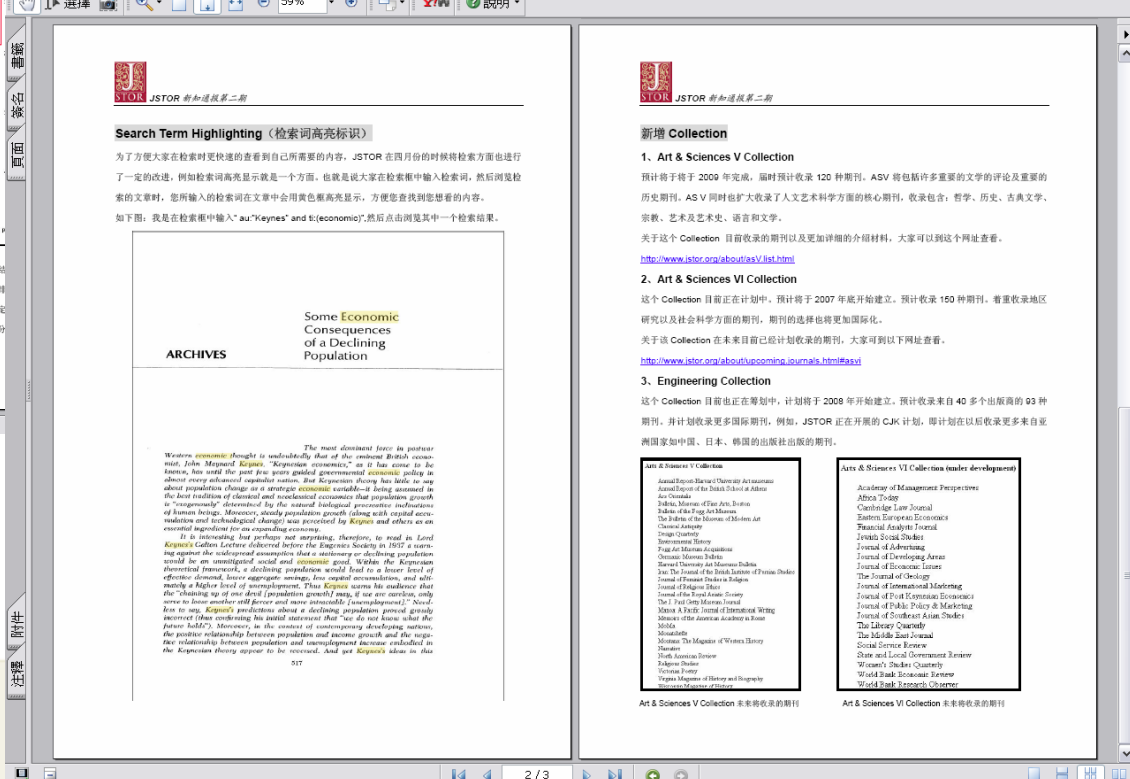

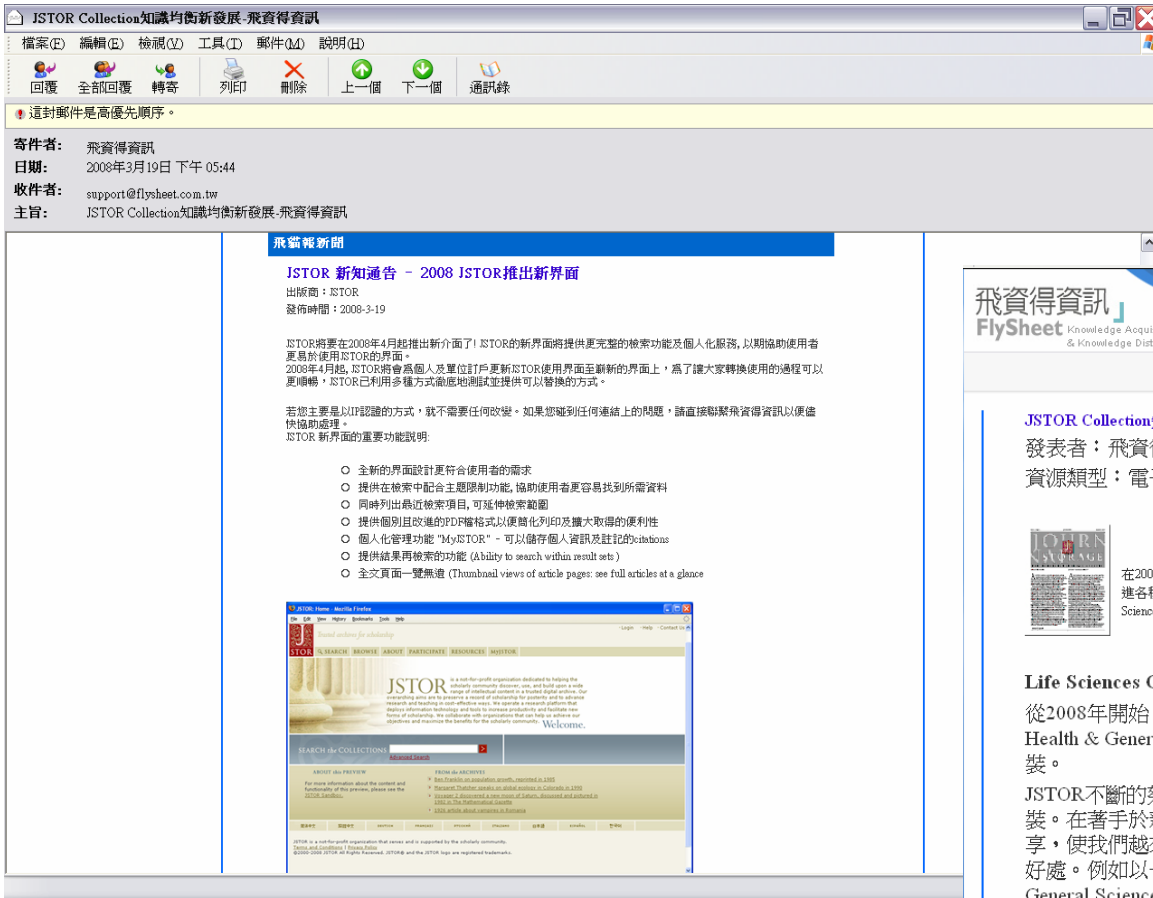
